As per details the 280 000 is the balance as per 28 Feb 2011 (Equip) so the sold equipt. is already deducted.

As per the deminishing balance method the acc depreciation must be deducted first and the balance on 30 Nov 2011 includes the 12 060 depreciation written off during the life span of the sold equipt. therefore it's deducted from the acc dep.

$212\ 060 \times 10\% = 21\ 206$

Vehicles:

$170\ 000 \times 20\% = 34\ 000$

I do not see a note that says how much of the 1.5 mil is the buildings worth.
